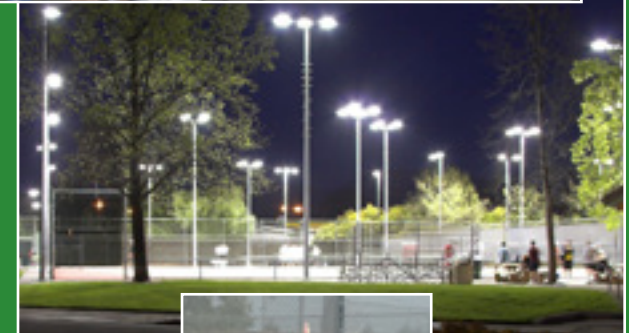

# What is the Walnut Creek Racquet Club?



The Walnut Creek Racquet Club (WCRC) was founded in 1969 as a public courts tennis club and is sponsored by the City of Walnut Creek. The club's purpose is to promote

the game of tennis in Walnut Creek by providing a wide variety of tennis activities including league play, tournaments, clinics and special events.

WCRC is open to both residents of Walnut Creek as well as non-residents as per its charter. Club membership, numbering over 1,200 tennis enthusiasts, is comprised of players of all ages and skill – all sharing a passion for the game.

## Where does the WCRC meet?

WCRC makes its home at the Walnut Creek Tennis Center in Heather Farms Community Park. The complex features ten courts, a full service Pro Shop and is lighted for night play.

## Membership Benefits

WCRC membership makes you eligible for all the activities that the club sponsors including:

- Tournaments

## USTA Adult and Senior Leagues

The club, in conjunction with the Walnut Creek Tennis Center, sponsors numerous USTA league teams throughout the year - Men's, Women's, Senior and Super Senior teams of various skill levels are available for member participation. Note: You must be a WCRC member and an active USTA member to play on sanctioned USTA League Team at the Tennis Center.

## Bay Area Ladies League (B.A.L.L.)

The WCRC provides an opportunity for club members to participate in various women's leagues. These leagues are played on weekday mornings. The leagues consist of B.A.L.L. (Bay Area Ladies League), B.A.L.L. Singles, Fall League, Spring League, Spring League Singles and Senior B.A.L.L. (50 years or older). The B.A.L.L. Leagues and Fall League begin in September and Spring League begins in January. Players must sign up by August 15 for B.A.L.L. and by November 30 for Spring.

## Social Tournaments and Events

In addition, the club has fun tournaments from February through November also special activities are held during the year for members.

## The Court Reporter

All members receive a monthly newsletter, *The Court Reporter*, to keep them informed of all club events and activities. The publication features a Calendar of Events, Special Club Events and Tournaments information and registration, current league results, new members list, USTA Team Summaries (Adult, Combo and Seniors).

## Men's and Women's

### Singles, Doubles and Mixed Leagues

For competitive players (2.5 to 5.5), the club runs both a Men's and Women's Singles League in the Summer, Doubles League in the Winter and Mixed Doubles in the Fall. Each league lasts three months during which time participants are provided a list of players in their division to arrange and complete matches. Results and standings are posted in real-time on the league website. A great way to meet new players in a competitive format!
